- 5 Compulsory School Attendance: The Illinois School Code states that children between the ages of 7 and 17 must attend public school; however, an exception is made for "... any child attending a private or parochial school where children are taught the branches of education taught to children of corresponding age and grade in the public schools, and where the instruction of the child in the branches of education is in the English language."
